



## 2012-2013 APPLICATION CHECKLIST AND PROCEDURES MIDDLE SCHOOL - GRADES 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup>

*INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS MUST USE THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION CHECK LIST POSTED SEPARATELY ON OUR WEBSITE*

- Please complete an application for each child and submit it to the Admissions Office with a \$150 non-refundable application/testing fee, per student, by Tuesday, January 24, 2012.
  - All applications are considered for the coming school year unless consideration for the current school year is requested.
  - Pinecrest follows an annual admissions process. Applicants who do not attend Pinecrest Academy in the year applied for must reapply for admission in subsequent years.
  - It is suggested that parents of future applicants contact the admissions office in the fall of the year prior to the school year that consideration is being requested.
- Have your child complete and submit the "Student Questionnaire" with the application.
- Submit a copy of your child's birth certificate with the application. Catholic applicants must submit a copy of their child's baptismal certificate, as well as a copy of the child's First Holy Communion certificate and Confirmation certificate, if applicable.
- Provide proof of residence for non-US citizens, with the application.
- Distribute the Student Evaluation forms to your child's current Language Arts and Mathematics teachers. Request that your child's teachers complete these forms and submit them with your child's transcript to Pinecrest Academy. For middle school students, please use the *Language Arts Teacher Student Evaluation Form and Math Teacher Student Evaluation Form*, respectively. *It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that the evaluations are forwarded to Pinecrest Academy by Tuesday, January 24, 2012.*
- Give the transcript request form to your child's current principal's office so that your child's complete official records will be forwarded to Pinecrest Academy by Tuesday, January 24, 2012. For middle school students, please use the *Transcript Release / Principal's Evaluation Form For Applicants to 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade* form. Please be sure to inform the school official that the records they will be forwarding to Pinecrest Academy must include your child's current grades and transcript.
- Register for the Secondary School Admissions Test (SSAT) and have the test scores sent to Pinecrest Academy's school code #5793. Detailed registration instructions can be found at [www.ssat.org](http://www.ssat.org). Test scores must be received by Pinecrest Academy before Friday, February 10, 2012.
- If applicable, tuition assistance requests must be applied for and supporting documentation submitted by Tuesday, February 7, 2012. For detailed tuition assistance information and requirements, please visit the tuition assistance menu on our web-site, [www.pinecrestacademy.org](http://www.pinecrestacademy.org). Tuition assistance recipients are not eligible for payment option discounts or sibling discounts. *There is no tuition assistance, at this time, for PreK or international students.*
- Make sure your child's file is complete by our January 24, 2012 deadline. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that all application documents and requirements are complete. An application is not considered complete, nor will Pinecrest Academy begin processing the application(s), until all of the required documents are submitted with required fee(s).

Expect Pinecrest Academy to confirm your completed application, including receipt of supporting documentation, and admissions testing fee, via letter scheduling your child's admissions testing, student interview, and parent interview in early February. Please secure the admissions assessment/testing and student interview dates outlined below:

- ❖ **First Wave Applicants:** Applicants who meet the January 24, 2012 application deadline (including all supporting documentation and non-refundable application fee), test on the testing dates listed below, and complete their parent interview before Friday, March 9, 2012, will be given first consideration to available grade openings. Testing and interview days are:
  - Kindergarten - 8<sup>th</sup> Grade - Friday, February 10, 2012
  - Pre-Kindergarten - Saturday, February 11, 2012
  - 4<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Student Interviews - Friday, February 10, 2012
  - Parent Interviews - between Thursday, February 16, 2012 and Friday, March 9, 2012.
- ❖ **Rolling Admissions Applicants:** Applicants who apply after the January 24, 2012 application deadline.
  - Student testing times and interviews are scheduled once all requested materials are received and fees are paid.
  - Parent interviews follow.
